**Business:**

1. Lobbyist presentation: Representative Botana gave the board a quick overview of his roll and how the process works. Lobbyist Andres Malave with Jones Walker gave the board a presentation of what his firm does and can do for the district in Tallahassee. The board asked questions of both Representative Botana and Mr. Malave.
2. 5-year plan update and discussion: The district received the estimated taxable value on June 1<sup>st</sup>, which was a 0.8% increase over the current fiscal year. Since this was significantly lower than originally projected and there was a significant increase last year from the estimate to the actual no additional projections were presented. The hard numbers come out on July 1<sup>st</sup> and the plan will be updated for the July workshop.
3. Lee County EMS agreement: Chief Mickuleit will hold this discussion for Wednesday's meeting when the district attorney can be in attendance.
